PLUG-IN INSTALLATION STEPS

Carefully remove metal box (chassis) from carton. Before you begin the installation process, make sure you have a phillips head screwdriver.

- 1. Mount metal box to wall studs to provide sufficient support. Mounting slots are provided in the chassis.
- 2. Check built-in balance to ensure that the chassis has been leveled.
- 3. Plug electrical cord into switched wall outlet.
- 4. Remove mirror plate/frame from carton. Install mirror plate/frame onto metal box using the angled cleat system.

This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable installation code by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product and the hazards involved.

Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor.
